Lyminge Micro Museum and Time Capsule!



Last year the Parish Council agreed that the telephone kiosk on Woodland Road, Lyminge could be converted into a micro-museum and to include a time capsule! We are now in the process of completing this time capsule for the Queen's Jubilee in June.
