As part of a new initiative, Police Contact Points have been launched in the east of the county in July. Police Contact Points are held each day from Wednesday through to Sunday, mainly in rural locations, on a rolling two-week schedule. Our police vans stop at a prominent location for one and a half hours per visit, enabling residents to drop by and speak to a neighbourhood officer about any policing concerns or issues they may have. The new Contact Points are in addition to the existing surgeries, meetings and online question and answer sessions local officers hold each month.

The contact points are available in Ashford, Canterbury, Dover, Shepway and Thanet. Residents can follow their progress on dedicated Twitter accounts. AUGUST IN THE GARDEN sponsored by LYMINGE GARDENERS'SOCIETY



August can often be the hottest month of the year so gardeners often spend much of it watering. Remember to water wisely, if your lawn is looking dry and worn don't waste valuable water it is much better to wait until autumn when an organic feed can be used and watered in with the autumnal rain, the grass will soon look lush again.

August offers gardener's a slight rest before the autumn rush to sit back and enjoy their hard work or even go away for the day or on holiday. Don't forget to move potted plants into the shade before leaving and why not try sitting them in a shallow container filled with water? If you have not yet booked anything Lyminge Gardeners' Society have arranged a coach trip to RHS Wisley on Tuesday 20th August, we do still have a few places left, the gardens should be looking fantastic.

Other jobs for August include, start ordering spring bulbs for September delivery and planting, collect seed from favourite plants, cut out old fruited canes on raspberries and lift and pot up rooted strawberry runners. A few minutes deadheading each day will keep the garden looking smart whilst encouraging plants to continue flowering.

If you have little ones at home or grandchildren encourage them to swap square eyes for green fingers by growing their own salad mix. Not only will this occupy them and drag them away from the TV and computer games it will teach them about where food comes from and how simple and rewarding gardening can be. Several seed suppliers sell what is known as 'Cut and Come Again Salad'. Simply fill a container such as a pot, bucket or window box with compost, thinly scatter the seed over the surface, sieve a little compost over the top and water. You should be harvesting your own salad within 3 to 6 weeks depending on the weather. Don't forget to keep weed free and water regularly. 




