
Rhodes Minnis Evening Circle


Merry Christmas to all our members and friends

The Great War Commemoration Event

As many are aware, next year marks the centenary of the outbreak of the First World War. The Lyminge Association Committee feels it would be respectful and fitting to commemorate the bravery of those who went to war, not forgetting all those left behind on the home front.

We are hoping to put on a one day Audio-Visual performance highlighting this, alongside an exhibition. As you may appreciate, with no one left alive who actually remembers this period, it will be quite difficult. So if you have any letters, memorabilia, or artifacts [a piece of uniform, badge/medal etc. or even a piece of 'trench art'] that you would be willing to lend for this event we should love to hear from you. Alternatively, some of our more 'senior' citizens may have memories of a father/grandfather/uncle who went to war or of those left behind and how they coped, that they could share with the village. This could include domestic equipment and tools that were used during the period.


