A recent research project carried out by Canterbury Christ Church University into community singing for older people found that singing promoted a range of medical benefits including social, emotional and physical well-being.

The Silver Song Club has been running at Age UK Lyminge for over three years, funded by East Kent Health Authority, but there has been no singing since July due to the reorganisation of the Health Service, which resulted in no further financial support being made available. I was part of the original research project and am a Director of Living Lively, the charity that started the very successful Lyminge Larks, so I would like to see singing start again at Age UK.

Since July I have been trying to find an alternative source of funding to continue this activity. A year's programme costs £600, which includes the services of a professional facilitator. We could start in January if we can find the funding. Age UK Lyminge has recently received some donations, which can be used towards starting the new singing sessions. We therefore need to find a further £90, which is half the cost, and this will enable us to run for three months until Easter while I look for more permanent sources of revenue. It will help you to build up a collection of useful resources and notes and teach you simple techniques to help you in your caring role.

Innovative Healthcare in Shepway - Pro-Active Care Programme

An innovative project in Shepway, Dover and Deal is making a real difference to the lives of people with long-term health problems. The Pro-Active Care Programme is for people who have at least two long-term health conditions and who have been admitted to hospital twice in the last 12 months. Selected patients are offered 12 weeks of intensive support led by their GP, with all relevant services coming together in a 'one-stop shop', held in the GP practice initially and then, usually, in patients' own homes.

Typically, a meeting might include the GP, community matron and pharmacist, district nurse, therapists, social care, health trainers and mental health professionals, as well as the patient and their family carer (if applicable). First, they all develop a plan of action to improve the patient's health and then, over the following weeks, make sure everything on it happens. Changes might include patients starting to use telehealth or telecare, having different medication, getting equipment from occupational therapy or intensive physiotherapy which helps them be more independent, support from a health trainer, and being put in touch with other services (such as Age UK, or weight management classes).

More than 100 patients have taken part in the programme since it started in May.

It was first developed as a pilot scheme in Liverpool in 2010, by GP Dr Tuan Nguyen, who in 2011 moved to Folkestone. He suggested to colleagues in South Kent Coast Clinical Commissioning Group (which consists of the GP practices in Shepway, Dover and Deal), Kent County Council, Kent Community Health NHS Trust and other local services that they adopt this model and they responded enthusiastically. Shepway, Dover and Deal are the only places outside the north west known to be using the scheme.

Seventeen local patients have completed the programme so far with 51 more due to do so by the end of the year and the others continuing into the New Year.

As well as bringing significant benefits to patients, this is saving the local NHS £2,000 per patient in A&E, inpatient and outpatient costs. Your surgery will be able to advise you as to your eligibility.



One subject that has not been covered in these articles so far is the weather. It is now twenty-five years since the "Hurricane" of 1987. I was living in Smeeth at that time and remember well the effect on that locality but I am less aware of what happened here, in the neighbourhood of Lyminge. Have you any memories of this storm? Let me know what you remember.

Several people have told me of the row of cottages in Rhodes Minnis that was badly damaged by a doodlebug, VI flying bomb. This row of cottages stood on the left hand side of the road at the top of Longage Hill. Contrary to secondary reports that I have heard, those that lived in the locality at the time do not recollect anyone being killed by the explosion. There were injuries but, fortunately, nobody died,. The building was still standing afterwards but had to be pulled down, as the cottages were uninhabitable.
