#### **Lyminge Archaeological Project 2013**

Reading University are returning to Lyminge this summer to continue their exciting excavation work on Tayne Field. Last year's dig revealed a significant timber frame hall dating from pre-Christian times with excavation work and finds cleaning involving many volunteers from the village.

This year the dig starts on **Monday 22nd July** and continues until Sunday 1st September. Once again local people are being invited to get involved. Those who have no excavation experience will be given an induction session in the Tayne Centre. These will be held on Saturday and Wednesday mornings for the first four weeks of the dig.

#### **Lyminge Weather Statistics – March 2013**

A cold month, as an area of relatively high pressure, wherein winds rotate in a clockwise direction, remained to the north and/or east of the British Isles. This: 1) Caused winds to be mainly north/north-east/easterly drawing in cold air from Scandinavia; 2) Prevented an area of low pressure, wherein the winds rotate in an anti-clockwise direction, moving in from the Atlantic Ocean which would have brought warmer south/south westerly winds.

#### **Lyminge Heritage Questions and Answers**

Flints are a common site in this locality, whether they are seen in newly ploughed fields or used as a building material in walls. They are so common that we probably do not think about their origin or uses but I think their commonness suggests that we should think a little here about this ubiquitous material.

These grey and black nodules that are white covered are a common sight in the North Downs. They tend to occur in seams in the upper layers of chalk and the grey/black material is almost pure silica. The method of formation of these nodules is not known for certain but is thought to be a process of crystallization of silica rich water in holes in the chalk. How and why this process happens is the subject of various theories. One theory is that the holes were caused by crustaceans or molluscs boring through the sedimentary layers that later became chalk whilst the silica may have come from marine sponges. It would seem that, like chalk, a process of fossilization of organic material possibly produces flints.

Flint has had a lot of uses through the centuries. Probably, the earliest use of flint was as scraping and cutting tools during the Stone Age as it splits into thin, sharp flakes when struck by another hard object. Neolithic people became very skilled at producing tools from flints by this process of 'knapping'. These skills have largely been lost but there are experts today who have studied the subject and have some success in producing flint tools. You may have seen the knapping demonstration at the archaeological excavation Open Day, on Tayne Field, last year?

Both knapped and un-knapped flints have been used since Roman times as a building material. Flints can be seen in the Roman Richborough Castle, near Sandwich and in Canterbury Cathedral. Closer to home there are several buildings with flints used in their construction; Flint Cottage in Rhodes Minnis is an example. On the Parish Church, flints have been used as a decoration. The flints have been knapped into small pieces and set at a diagonal in the mortar.

Since Roman times it has been known that flint struck against iron produces a spark which can in turn produce fire when the spark is applied to suitable tinder. This reached something of an apogee in the flintlock mechanism which was used in firearms and fire starting tools. Flints were used in the ceramics industry but have now been replaced by another silica based mineral, quartz. As far back as Egyptian times, flints were used in jewellery and striped & patterned flints are used, in jewellery making, today.



# Jubilee Memorial Stone

During the early part of arranging the Queen's Diamond Jubilee celebrations last year, the organising committee, made up of representatives of most parish organisations, considered how to commemorate the event on a permanent basis. In Etchinghill



the Petanque court was named in the Queen's honour and a memorial bench will be installed on the amenity land near the village hall. Another memorial bench was installed on the recreation ground at Rhodes Minnis. Both of these were financed by voluntary contribution and supported by Parish Council grant. In Lyminge, , a commemoration stone, in the shape of an orientation-table will be placed on Tayne Field, to the north of the small children's playground, both for the village and for the whole parish.

An orientation-table indicates where the reader is in relation to other significant points. In our case the stone will have the word Lyminge at its centre and will have lines indicating the directions to Canterbury, Dover and Folkestone, as well as London, Winchester, once England's capital city, and York, once the capital of the north and the other Archbishop's see. Around the edge of the stone the words 'HM Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee June 2012' will be carved.

Production of the stone and arrangements for establishing a base and surround are well in hand. Volunteer labour is willing to dig the foundations and build the base. Care has been taken to ensure that the stone will not cause obstruction to the area where children play. A ceremony will be held in the autumn to unveil the memorial stone. In the meantime, any further donations towards the cost of this project would be welcome. An artist's impression of the stone in position is shown above.


