NOVEMBER IN THE GARDEN - LYMINGE GARDENERS' SOCIETY

Have you planted your spring bulbs yet? It is not too late to plant Tulips for late spring colour. Other bulbs that should have been planted by now can still be planted near the relative warmth of the house. In a pot by the back door is ideal.

Although the winter is fast approaching there are still many things to do in the garden. If you have a greenhouse or cold frame try sowing some sweet peas in early November to overwinter, this will provide a good strong plant for colour next year. Fallen leaves can be turned into mulch; once you have collected the leaves put them in a black sack with a few holes in the bottom, water the leaves but allow the water to drain from the holes. In about 9 to 12 months you will have your free organic product.

Prepared bulbs can be planted indoors now and provide colour for you home in mid-winter.

At our next meeting on Tuesday 19th November our talk 'Xmas Tales', by Mrs Janet Bryant will give ideas as well as some history about plants that are often associated with Christmas. This is also the last date members can book for our Christmas meal on Tuesday 17th December, a 2 course traditional Christmas dinner with all the trimmings for £5. After Christmas try growing your own early new potatoes. Buy seed potatoes early in the New Year and allow them to sprout in a cool frost free place with good light, an egg box is ideal to put them in. At the end of January when the tubers have sprouted plant them in a large pot or other container in about 4-5 inches of compost, water and place in a cool but frost free place. When the shoots appear add another level of compost and keep doing this until the pot is full, by mid-April you should have your first crop of potatoes.

Winter provides a chance to sit back and review the previous year's successes and failures, as well as an opportunity to plan next year's growing season. As the weather gets cold please do not forget to feed the birds and provide them with some water to drink. Insects and bugs will appreciate a small area left untidy to overwinter in. Next year Lyminge Gardener's Society has another full and varied programme arranged. Membership is just £5 for the year, an ideal Christmas present for yourself or a loved one!

Kent Fire and Rescue Service (KFRS) is warning residents of potential fire hazards as households feel the pinch of fuel costs and switch to alternative ways of keeping warm as the weather gets colder. Research shows that those most at risk are people who live alone and on a low income, with older people or single-parent families even more vulnerable. Area Manager Community Safety Stuart Skilton said: "With high gas and electricity prices, some residents may struggle to make ends meet and there is a real concern they may resort to more risky methods of heating and lighting their homes, resulting in more accidental fires. I appeal to all residents to ensure you have working smoke alarms fitted in your property to provide early warning of fire and to think very carefully before taking a cost-cutting risk that could result in you getting

Follow this advice to avoid cost-cutting risks that could take your life are:

seriously injured or killed in a fire."

- Make sure chimney and flues are checked and swept before use. Burning wood or other fossil fuels in open fires and stoves that have a build up of soot or in a poor state of repair can cause a chimney fire.
- Ensure any electric or gas heater is fully inspected and fit for use and never use them to dry washing. Using old and potentially faulty portable heaters and oil or paraffin stoves are particularly hazardous in the home, especially if positioned close to furniture or upholstery.
- Check electric blankets are in good working order before use. Never use an electric blanket that is over 10-years-old and always ensure you follow the manufactures instructions.
- Avoid using candles and paraffin lamps for lighting instead of switching on the lights never leave naked flames unattended and exercise extreme caution if burning other fuels.
- Only use cooking appliances intended for use indoors. Never use Calor gas stoves or barbecues indoors to cook with these items should never be used indoors as they are a serious fire hazard and create deadly toxic fumes.
- Consider installing a carbon monoxide detector to help prevent the risk of carbon-monoxide poisoning




