

World War 1 Memorabilia


You may remember that last month the Lyminge Association started the appeal for memorabilia of the First World War to help in the commemoration of the events of the centenary that falls on 4th August 2014.

Innovative new NHS service to help South Kent Coast people know where to go for treatment

The NHS has launched an innovative new service to help people in Dover, Deal and Shepway and the whole of Kent and Medway to understand where they should go for treatment, especially when they need healthcare in a hurry or late at night or weekends.

The **Health Help Now** web app can be found online at www.healthhelpnow-nhs.net and is free to everyone who lives and works in Kent and Medway. It functions like a mobile phone app and helps people check their symptoms and find the best place for treatment – showing which services near them are open. It will help people to know when to go to A&E, and when not to. It breaks down symptoms by age – baby, child, teenager, adult and older adult. This is to make it easier for people to find the right treatment for them.

Health Help Now has been developed with input from local GPs, hospital doctors, paramedics and other health professionals. After clicking on age, symptoms and location, people are presented with a list of suggestions for treatment. The most suitable choice for most people is listed first and the other suggestions follow in order. It shows the nearest services, is time sensitive providing details of whether services are open or closed as well as showing a map of their location. **Health Help Now** also offers advice – such as where to buy children's medication when pharmacies are closed - and links to other useful websites.

The ground-breaking, easy-to-use web app works on smartphones, tablets, laptops and desktop computers.

The web app will initially be available via the website <u>www.healthhelpnow-nhs.net</u> and can be saved to your phone, tablet or computer for easy use. It will be launched as a free mobile phone app in 2014.

Anyone who doesn't have internet access is advised to dial NHS 111 for urgent healthcare advice 24 hours a day.

Not everyone loved Christmas

Christmas may have been stressful for some of our friends in our community. Family pressures, expectations and money worries can make for a difficult mix. And the desire to make sure everyone was happy and having a good time adds to the strain. For people already coping with serious problems in their lives, the festive season may have made them feel significantly worse. Of course, it's not just Christmas that can cause stress. People with money or work worries, relationship anxieties or those who care for someone with a long-term health condition can also be at higher risk of anxiety and depression. That's why NHS South Kent Coast Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) is reminding people that support is available.

The **Mental Health Matters** helpline (0800 107 0160) offers confidential emotional support and guidance for people in Kent and Medway 24 hours a day, every day of the year. Helpline staff are trained in counselling, so can provide support over the phone. And they also have details of local and national services if people want more support.


Samaritans provides confidential support for anyone feeling down, depressed or anxious, as well as those who may be feeling despair. Volunteers can be contacted 24/7 on 08457 90 90 90, email jo@samaritans.org or faceto-face; visit www.samaritans.org for details of your local branch.

People whose daily lives are being affected by anxiety, depression or other common mental health problems may also be eligible for free NHS talking therapy.

Dr Chaudhuri added: "People can refer themselves for a talking therapy – the details are on the Live It Well website (**www.liveitwell.org.uk**) – or they can talk to their GP about it. The website, which is for Kent and Medway, also has details of ways to wellbeing which can make it easier to cope and to get more out of life in general. I'd also ask local people to consider the 'ways to wellbeing'. Small differences can make a real and positive difference."

SAFEGUARD your nearest and dearest from fire

When a fire engine zooms down the road on flashing blue lights with sirens blazing, often the first thing people think is "I hope it's not a fire in my home or that of someone I know". But how often do you take the time to check that your nearest and dearest are fully equipped with the right advice to protect themselves and their homes from fire?

Kent Fire and Rescue Service (KFRS) is appealing to residents to make sure their homes, and those of people close to them, are safeguarded.

KFRS Community Safety Manager Stuart Skilton said: "Just three breaths of toxic smoke from a fire can be lifethreatening, but we offer free safety advice and services to help minimise the risk of being harmed."

"Neighbours, friends and loved-ones may need your help to protect themselves from the outbreak of fire. Perhaps you have an elderly parent, or know someone who lives alone, or with young children, who could benefit from safety advice or need help to test their smoke alarms. Maybe your own children are now grown-up, starting a family of their own and need some tips on fire prevention."

Where needed, KFRS offers people practical help to reduce the risk of fire. Maybe they need a smoke alarm fitted, advice on escape routes and what to do if a fire starts in their home. Or perhaps they need some more extra guidance to keep safe. KFRS has a dedicated team can provide specialist advice and equipment, such as fireproof bedding and smoke alarms for the hard of hearing, to help protect more vulnerable residents.

Stuart added: "By encouraging those you care about to get in touch, you will be playing a huge part in preventing a fire and may even save a life."

Tips on staying safe from fire:

- Make sure you fit, and regularly test, a smoke alarm. It is the single most important piece of safety equipment in any home
- If you plan on using an open fire, make sure your chimney has been recently swept as build-ups of soot and ash can cause chimney fires. Use a fire or spark guard to prevent accidental fires
- When going to bed, make absolutely certain that any open fire is either out, or pushed back into the grate and a guard used to prevent sparks setting light to carpets or furniture
- · Interior doors should always be closed when going to bed as they can dramatically reduce the spread of fire
- · Portable heaters should be dust-free and kept well away from anything that could catch fire
- Always place candles on a non-flammable surface away from soft furnishing like curtains and never leave them unattended. It is far safer to consider using torches instead of candles.



A great story, an atmospheric set and very realistic characters made the show a great success.






