



District Councillors Update - March 2017

From your District Councillors

We were both able to attend the meeting of Lyminge Parish Council on 30 January which included an excellent presentation by Susan Foster of Age UK on the work done by the Lyminge centre. Anyone over the age of 50 who lives in the Lyminge parish is eligible for services (which are very reasonably priced) ranging from gardening, mending and altering clothes, laundry and meals delivered to your home or you can be picked up and taken to the Lyminge Centre for meals, hairdressing, chiropody, hearing tests and much more. Age UK is very well supported by volunteers from the village but it is keen that more people take advantage of what it offers. Susan has allocated a £271 Shepway ward grant to Lyminge Age UK for a new shed for storage. (Jenny allocated them a grant last year). If you have a community project that would benefit from a grant, please let us know.

Last year we visited several new leisure centres in other parts of the country to help us plan the new leisure centre (including a swimming pool). We were very struck by how many retired people were using the gym equipment and taking part in classes during the day. In the evenings the working age population took over and all ages loved the opportunity to get fit and socialise. This is just the sort of use we want for Shepway's new leisure centre. Our project took a big step forward when the Shepway cabinet agreed on 07 February to make a planning application for the new leisure centre, parkland and houses at Princes Parade in Hythe.

Jenny was involved in a 'Safety in Action' Day for Year 6 children from 22 local Primary Schools which covered road, fire, sea, rail, health and personal safety and it is hoped to extend this to all Shepway Primary Schools next year.

As reported last month, the Kent & Medway Armed Forces Covenant Conference will be held at the Leas Cliff Hall on 14 March. If any organisation associated with the Armed Forces has not received an invitation to attend please let Jenny know.

Jenny attended the District Councils Network Annual Conference on 02/03 February and heard both Gavin Barwell MP, the Housing Minister and Sajid Javid MP the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government emphasis the role of District Councils in providing housing of all types for future generations. Shepway is certainly doing that and the next round of consultation meetings for the garden town proposed at Otterpool Park will be held in April (the Shepway website will have venues and dates nearer the time). Jenny is the Shepway representative on the local Health and Wellbeing Board and reports that at their last meeting there was a presentation on Otterpool Park to ensure all Health Services are fully aware of the proposal and involved in the master planning process.

Finally you may have heard there is a proposal to abolish Shepway, Canterbury, Dover and Thanet councils and establish a new East Kent council to save money. The councils will be debating this on 22 March and, if the councillors think the idea should be taken further, there will then be public engagement about the idea. Jenny is still uncertain about the merits of the proposal and Susan thinks the benefits are too small and the risks too great. We will let you know more in our next report.

Things-To-Do in March to Get Your Garden Ready for the Garden Safari, 24th & 25th June

In the flower garden

- If the soil is workable, dig in a 5cm layer of compost or well rotted manure or a general purpose fertilizer.
- If you need to move deciduous trees or shrubs, now is the time to do it.
- Feed trees, shrubs & hedges with slow-release fertiliser
- Plant summer-flowering bulbs such as Gladiolus, Lilies and Ranunculus into beds, borders and containers.
- Now is an ideal time to plant herbaceous perennials. Lift and divide established perennial plants now to improve their vigour and create new plants for your garden.
- Plant bare root roses. Feed roses as they come into growth. Prune them to encourage strong new growth.
- Sow your flower seeds now so they are ready for planting out in June.
- Hardy annuals can be sown directly into the soil.
 Alternatively sow them in pots or module trays for planting out later in the spring.
- Prune early-flowering Clematis once their flowers have finished and summer-flowering Clematis before they start into active growth.
- Cut back shrubs grown for their colourful winter stems such as Cornus and Salix cultivars.

- Cut out the top rosette of leaves from Mahonia shrubs after they have flowered
- Prune overwintered fuchsias back to one or two buds
- Prune Winter Flowering Jasmine after flowering
- Trim winter-flowering heathers as the flowers disappear, to prevent the plants becoming leggy.
- Cut off the old leaves of Hellebores
- Deadhead faded flowers from your winter pansies
- Deadhead daffodils as the flowers finish and let the foliage die back naturally.
- Dead-head Hydrangeas before new growth appears.
- Keep an eye out for slugs as the weather warms. Use nematodes for an effective organic control.

In the vegetable garden

- Begin chitting (sprouting) seed potatoes.
- Plant asparagus beds from crowns.
- Plant onion, shallot and garlic sets
- Start to direct sow vegetable seeds such as carrots, radishes and lettuce in greenhouse borders or under cloches.

Looking after your lawn

- Recut any lawn edges if necessary.
- If your lawn needs mowing choose a dry day.
- New turf can be laid if the ground is not frozen or waterlogged.
- If you'd rather grow your lawn from seed, prepare the soil now to allow it time to settle before sowing.




