

Pathways to the Past: Exploring the Legacy of Ethelburga

Readers of our project blog will already know that we have been posting lots of new information over the past few weeks:

• See what we are planning on the sequence of 3D reconstructions of the church site over the past 1400



• Follow our intrepid walker Philip Blanch as he explores our new walking route the "Royal Saxon Way" on a coast to coast journey from Folkestone to Minster.

Our project plans continue to take shape. We will soon have a design for the work we are proposing to improve the paths in and around the churchyard for those with impaired mobility and create step-free access to the church for the first time. The community benefits achieved through these improvements are critical to securing permission for the project and obtaining the bulk of the funding we need. We believe our plans will deliver tangible benefits for many people in our community.

We are in the process of collecting quotes for the work we are planning and continue to approach various charitable bodies to seek grants. However, while other grants are important, we will be seeking the bulk of the money we need from the Heritage Lottery Fund. We intend to submit this application in January.

But grants will only get us so far. We need more help if we are to deliver on all our plans. This is why we have launched a public appeal for donations. This appeal is specifically targeting creation of the 3D reconstructions of the church through time. We aim to make these available through a monitor in the church and on-line. 

District Councillors Update - December 2018

The Post Office contacted our MP, Damian Collins and Susan on 31 October to say it is in the final stages of appointing a new Postmaster for Lyminge. Good news indeed but despite pressing we have no further news for you at this stage.

Other good news is that we have been able to meet in full a request to fund chairs for the new Dementia Wing at Age UK in Lyminge. We jointly gave £700 from our District Council ward grant and Susan met the balance of £3,878 from her KCC Member Grant. On top of this Jenny attended the opening of the new wing on 02 November and presented a cheque for £200 to Age UK as they had won the prize offered as an incentive to local groups to register on the new Spotlight website listing activities and services across our district.

To complete the news on grants we are also pleased to confirm an award of £300 from our District Council ward grant to the Etchinghill Residents Association towards the cost of an electricity supply to their Christmas tree which has now grown too big for its former system of car batteries to power the lights. It should be a grand display from 02 December.

We are fortunate to have very few problems with Anti-Social Behaviour in Lyminge. Unfortunately other parts of our district, particularly the towns, do suffer from ASB and, to help control this, the District Council is able to use Public Space Protection Orders. The present set of PSPOs is due for replacement by June 2019 and the public is being asked for their views on what is needed.

There are seven PSPOs proposed covering behaviour in a public space, control of alcohol consumption, no use of intoxicating substances, no urinating, spitting or defecating, no begging, no excessive noise when busking (e.g. amplified music), restrictions on the number of 'chuggers' (charity collectors) and no unauthorised camping in open spaces

The play areas which would be protected from unauthorised camping are at Meriden Park in Etchinghill and Mount Pleasant Close in Lyminge and the churchyards at Lyminge Methodist Church, St Mary and St Ethelburga Church in Lyminge and St Mary and St Radegund Church in Postling. None of the other measures includes any of Lyminge or Postling parishes but the consultation gives you the chance to say if you think any of it should apply and to give your views on the restrictions proposed elsewhere.

We want to stress that the PSPOs are about known problems in specific areas which have made life very unpleasant for residents. They are not about targeting the homeless who are always offered help by the council staff. You can read more about the consultation and have your say on the council website www.folkestone-hythe.gov.uk or contact us.

Jenny attended UK Power Networks Seminar recently and great emphasis was put on making sure local residents with older or disabled people, those with children under five, or where someone uses medical or mobility equipment that requires electricity as well as other reasons should be registered on their Priority Service Register. This means that they will be contacted should there be a power cut and if necessary special arrangements put in place. To register go to ukpowernetworks.co.uk/priority

At this time of the year, it is important to acknowledge the voluntary work carried out by so many people in the parish - the Parish Councils, the Parents and Friends Association and Governors at the School, the Village Halls (Lyminge, Etchinghill, Rhodes Minnis and Postling), the Tayne Centre, Age UK, the Lyminge Association, Neighbourhood Watch and all the many clubs, societies and children's activities in the area. Thank you so much for all your work, it is appreciated. Our particular thanks go to Peter Barnes the editor of this newsletter and all those who distribute it. They do a grand job and we are lucky to have them.

A GUIDE TO RECYCLING



Q Is recycling worthwhile?



responsibly. No waste is sent to China and all plastics are sorted into their various types and transported to reprocessing facilities where they are washed and reprocessed into either flakes and pellets

Kent's waste ends up as landfill as what can't be recycled goes to our incinerator at Allington and is turned into energy (up to 263 million kilowatts of electricity can be generated every year).

Top tip – if you aren't sure if something can be recycled please put it in the landfill bin. It's important that recyclable waste is not contaminated by waste that is not recyclable. Tonnes of perfectly good recyclable waste can be spoiled by people who are trying too hard.

Thank you for recycling. Remember the best way to reduce waste is not to produce any in the first place. REDUCE, RE-USE AND RECYCLE IN THAT ORDER PLEASE!




