

## Canterbury Cathedral

The Lyminge-based choir, *Cantores Dominicae*, will be marking the centenary of the ending of the First World War with a special weekend of choral events to be held in Canterbury Cathedral, *focussing on mutual remembrance and reconciliation*.

**12.00 Saturday 10th November:** Lunchtime concert performed by Cantores Dominicae and Heinrich-Schütz-Kantorei from Kiel, including some movements from Brahms' German Requiem.

**18.15 Sunday 11th November:** Cantores Dominicae will be joined by Heinrich-Schütz-Kantorei, the Oyster Singers from Whitstable and the Canterbury Singers. These four choirs will perform Remembrance & Reconciliation composed by Cantores' Musical Director, Adrian Bawtree. More than 200 musicians from Britain and Germany will be taking part in this unique performance.

#### Rhodes Minnis Circle

Our meeting in September was a talk given by John and Jane Buss on the **Fabian Ware War Graves**.

Born in 1869 Fabian Ware was self-educated. He obtained a degree and became a teacher, eventually establishing schools and colleges in South Africa. He was instrumental in setting up proper graves, with names where possible, for relatives to remember the dead of the 1st World War. He organised a mobile Red Cross ambulance unit which rescued casualties and took names and positions of the fallen.

The Army eventually became involved and an office was set up to record and photograph graves for the families. A Royal Charter was set up in 1917 to establish the War Graves Commission and to plan the setting-up of cemeteries in France. Each grave was given a Portland stone headstone with a small garden which the French government agreed to keep for perpetuity and which the War Graves Commission continue to look after.

The competition was won jointly by Connie Burren and Marion Hoare, with Pauline Hodder 2nd, Gladys Harris 3rd, and Marilyn Norton and Diana Bennet joint 4th.

On 28th November Melanie Gibson-Barton will be giving a presentation on **Bruges**.

## There But Not There

A Memorial to The Fallen of the First World War



During 2016, a resident of Penshurst, Kent was inspired by the centenary of the start of the Great War. He wanted to bring those men who had left Penshurst to fight and who had never returned, back into the village. He achieved this by placing Perspex figures in the church to represent the Fallen, along with full size silhouettes on the roads leading into Penshurst.

The concept spread, with several other parishes in the country, including Lyminge, joining in to start the **There But Not There** project. Since then it has grown into a major charitable project under the title of "**Remembered**" with the aim of the whole project being to 'Commemorate, Educate and Heal'.

Early in November you will see three silhouettes of a First World War soldier, one at each of the entrances to Lyminge. You may also witness 28 transparent figures sitting in the pews of the Parish Church representing the 28 Lyminge men who died in the First World War and whose names can be found on our War Memorial in the grounds of the Parish Church.

The whole project has been overseen by The Lyminge Association which partially funded the local project along with significant donations from the Parish Church, local individuals and other organisations within our area.

## District Councillors Update - November 2018

We write in this newsletter every month, attend the parish council meetings at Lyminge and Postling and as many local events as we can but there's nothing beats calling door to door to get your views. Accompanied by our MP Damian Collins we've been out door knocking to meet people and listen. One of the things we heard was a request for more information about what's happening about housing plans in the area. It's a big topic but here goes.

The Places and Policies Local Plan sets out which land in our district can be used for new homes and jobs as well as policies for managing this development. It has been out for consultation at every stage of drafting and has now been submitted to the Government. The Government will now assign an Independent Planning Inspector to assess the plan, review all the representations made and evidence submitted.

The Inspector will also hold public hearings (probably in December) which could last two to three weeks. The Inspector may invite those who made representations at the last stage of consultation to put their views or submit further supporting evidence. Only those who made representations at the final stage of consultation may take part in this final stage although the meetings will be open to the public to watch.

When the Planning Inspector has all the information needed, s/he issues a final report. If the Plan is found 'sound' the council can then formally adopt it probably in June/July 2019. The Inspector may require changes in which case the process will take longer. Once in place the Plan officially lasts till 2031.

Alongside the **Places and Policies Local Plan**, the District Council is also working on a **Core Strategy Review** which extends the Plan to 2037 and includes Otterpool Park Garden Town (essentially the village of Westenhanger and land between Sellindge and Lympne). This will have its own public examination later in 2019.

It has been a long and detailed process which needs to be robust to withstand potential legal challenge from landowners and developers and allow your District Council to fulfill its legal responsibility to allocate sufficient land to meet the need for new homes and jobs.

We believe we have a robust Local Plan which will protect our district from speculative development and now wait the Planning Inspector's verdict.

Meanwhile, the long awaited planning application for Folkestone Seafront (part of the present Local Plan) has been submitted. The Harbour Arm has already been restored and has proved a real success with visitors. This latest application is for the first 84 of the 1,000 new homes, parking, amenity space and public realm improvements such as a shingle garden, play space and exercise facilities. Details are on the Council's website and the application reference is Y18/1252/FH.

We are pleased to report that the Government has given the District Council a £2.9m grant to accelerate housing developments at Princes Parade, Hythe and Biggins Wood in Folkestone. Together, these projects will provide more than 220 new homes, including 68 affordable homes.

Unfortunately one consequence of drivers trying to park without restricting the flow of traffic is the practice of parking partially on the footpath.

This can lead to pedestrians, especially those with pushchairs and young children, having to pass parked vehicles by walking in the road, putting themselves and children at risk. The answer to this is for all drivers to think when they park. However, the frequency of parking on the footpath dwarfs the partially blocking of the flow of traffic, with footpath parking occurring on a daily basis, while complete road blocking occurs perhaps once or twice a month.

Let us all park with consideration for both pedestrians and other road users.




