District Councillors Update - November 2019

We've written before about the District Council's plans to build a new Garden Town at Otterpool Park near Westenhanger rail station and Junction 11 of the M20 where there's space to provide homes and jobs and the infrastructure needed to support them. One aspect of the development that hasn't received much attention is the inclusion of land for self-build. How much land is set aside for this will depend on demand which is why we want to bring it to people's attention now. The new town at Graven Hill in Bicester is already doing this – see www.gravenhill.co.uk

Self-build is not just about 'grand designs' but a way to make home ownership more affordable. Stamp duty is only paid on the value of the land not the completed house and you can claim back VAT on the allowable costs of your building materials. You also save money by building exactly what you want – the right number of bedrooms, bathrooms etc. and your choice of fittings.

Folkestone & Hythe has a self-build register for those who are interested in building a house this way and as plans for Otterpool Park are developed there will be more opportunity for people to buy self-build plots.

Otterpool Park is a very important project for the District Council but there's lots more going on. We are considering options for the management of our 3,619 council homes following shortcomings in East Kent Housing, looking at ways to increase recycling, working with people to help them avoid homelessness and with rough sleepers to get them to accept the help on offer. You will find information on this and more on our website.

Some of you may know about National Coastwatch. They are a voluntary organisation providing 'Eyes along the Coast' keeping an eye on shipping and a lookout for anyone along the coast who may be in trouble. We are fortunate to have a branch locally, NCI (Folkestone) and Susan is their honorary president. It's the 25th anniversary of National Coastwatch and the national president, Lesley Suddes, was the guest of honour at a dinner held at Etchinghill Golf Club on 19 October. There's always room for more volunteers so if you'd like to find out more about NCI do contact Susan and, as ever, we are both happy to meet with local residents who want to discuss any district council matters with us.



PATHWAYS TO THE PAST

Exploring the Legacy of Ethelburga

Work is progressing in the churchyard with the back-filling of the archaeology now complete. The preparation work for laying the new paths is in hand as we go to press and we hope to have these finished in the near future.

Our first project publication, "Diary of a Dig", is now available and can be bought either from the village library during opening hours or direct from Liz Coleman at Sunny Cottage

(behind the Coffee Cabin in Canterbury Road). This is an edited version of our daily blog using lots of the photos taken as the archaeology was revealed. It is a super record of the excitement of the excavation as it took place. Get your limited edition souvenir of this internationally important event for just £5.

We announced last month that we have appointed White Cliffs Countryside Partnership as manager for our community engagement programme. WCCP have begun writing to village organisations to invite proposals for activities and requests for funding from our project budget. We are currently discussing plans for an Anglo-Saxon Festival to be held in the second half of August next year, and some activities may fit well as part of this. Watch this space for further details. In the meantime, if you are interested in putting on an event, do get in touch.

Climate Change and Our Community

Last month, on the back of the Parish Council Newsletter was a Feedback Form that reflects the start of a new community group focused on creating a meaningful approach to climatic changes. As the group seeks to gain members and structure itself around what matters to them, work is already afoot.

The Lyminge Parish Natural Environment Group known as 'Stepping Stones' have been creating space for pollinators within our community. On the bumpy field next to Lyminge Village Hall we have created seven native wildflower plots. You will see we have used a rotavator to create the plots. This is to give the seeds the best opportunity to germinate and take hold.



So why are we doing this? Firstly we want to encourage more of our community to use our green spaces and with the 28 new trees at the top of the green (our deepest gratitude to the Seymour Family) we are hoping to create a beautiful open space for all. Secondly, more than 40%



of insect species are declining and a third are endangered. The rate of extinction is eight times faster than that of mammals, birds and reptiles. The total mass of insects is falling by a precipitous 2.5% a year, according to the best data available, suggesting they could vanish within a century. We hope that the new flower plots will encourage and support new habitats for insects.

We hope you enjoy the flowers and the new natural habitats that they will create!






