
# ..and there's more

# District Councillors Update - October 2019

We are sorry to report that there have been grave shortcomings in how regular safety inspections and repairs have been carried out in our social housing. This work is undertaken on behalf of four councils (Folkestone & Hythe, Canterbury, Dover and Thanet) by East Kent Housing. The problems are being rectified as a matter of urgency and councillors will be considering how best to manage our homes in future. We may take the management back in-house. If any council house tenant would like us to meet with them to answer questions then please let us know and we will either meet with you in your home or at the council offices.

Jenny is the councillor responsible for our Armed Forces Covenant which is a commitment from the council to help Armed Forces personnel and their families. Folkestone & Hythe recently received a Silver Award for its work in this area. You can read more about this on the council's website.

We are very pleased to report that the council has bought Westenhanger Castle. The castle and grounds will now be fully integrated in the plans for Otterpool Park Garden Town. This means that the original approach to the castle from Sellindge will be re-instated, the moat restored and the 14 acres of parkland become part of the publicly accessible green space. The castle is currently used as a wedding and conference venue and this use will continue but we hope to improve access to the castle and make it the centrepiece of the garden town.

A 2-day study tour of garden towns was recently arranged for councillors from the district council and the nearest parish councils. Susan was able to join them and see the progress made at Alconbury which was an airfield. Two years ago it had a primary school but no occupied houses. People have now moved in and it also has a cricket pitch, an outdoor swimming pool, a business centre, shops and avenues of trees. The original garden city of Letchworth was also on the itinerary and the plans for building more homes here were shared. We saw part of the three attractive new towns in the Cambridge area and one site where a developer had been able to build homes with no facilities (other than a new roundabout) because the local council had tried to block new developments (failing in its statutory duty to designate enough sites) and been overruled by the Planning Inspectorate.

We both attended the meeting on 20 August hosted by Lyminge Parish Council on climate change. The District council is committed to 'zero carbon' for its own activities and Kent County Council has a zero-carbon ambition for the whole of Kent and Medway by 2050.

# Fifth Trust Update New Sparkling Wines have arrived!!

# **Pathways to the Past**



**Exploring the Legacy of Ethelburga** 

The dig is now over but you can recapture the excitement of daily discoveries with "Diary of a Dig", an edited version of our daily blog. This is volume 1 of what we intend to be a series of new publications focused on the archaeology of Lyminge. We hope this will be on sale through the usual village outlets. Watch for posters to find out more details.

We are delighted to announce that we have appointed White Cliffs Countryside Partnership as manager for our community engagement programme. WCCP bring extensive knowledge and experience in this field over many years with initiatives such as the hugely popular Green Gang. We will be reaching out to village organisations to see if they want to take part. In the meantime, if you have ideas, please let us know. We are looking for proposals so we can have a good programme of activities for 2020.

With the dig complete, by the time you read this, the contractors should be back in the churchyard back-filling the archaeology. New paths will be laid to the north door of the church to create step-free access, and to the war memorial, and a new surface will be laid throughout where previously we had tarmac. We hope to have this complete by early November.

We are still fund-raising and we still need to find funding for the creation of the digital 3D reconstructions of the church throughout its 1,400 year history. 
