District Councillors' Update - March 2020

We are pleased to report that we have been able to award a £2,400 grant to the Lyminge Playpark project. Ward grants were first introduced in 2012 and over the years they've enabled us to support many projects in the villages we represent. If you have a good local project then do let us know. The grant for the playpark is by far the single largest award we have ever made and is in recognition of the high initial costs of the equipment.

We have more news about the District Council's project to build a new Garden Town over the next 30 years at Otterpool Park (broadly the land between Junction 11 of the M20 motorway, Sellindge and Lympne). On 06 February the District Council bought the land held by Cozumel Estates its private sector partner in the Otterpool Park project. The purchase includes the former Folkestone Racecourse and several houses, a total of approximately 200 acres as well as the options to buy neighbouring farmland of a further 440 acres. The purchase price was £25m. This means the District Council is now the major landowner for Otterpool Park. Homes England, the Government agency that funds affordable housing bought land in the Otterpool area in 2018 and will continue as a partner in delivering the new homes, employment sites and community facilities.

The Government has been very supportive of the plans for Otterpool Park providing grants towards the planning costs. On 14 January it announced a further grant towards Otterpool Park of £580,000 (the single largest grant made from a £6m fund specifically for the creation of garden communities across the country). You can find more information about Otterpool Park at www.otterpoolpark.org and we are both happy to discuss this project (or any other District Council matter) with residents.

In other District Council news, David Monk, the Leader of the council has invited the leaders of each of the opposition groups to join the council's cabinet. As far as we know, this is a unique arrangement for a council and so far only the Greens and Liberal Democrats have accepted. It is hoped this will provide stability for the council.

You may have noticed a new development by Pentland Homes off Stone Street in Stelling Minnis. This was the site of a derelict egg factory and now has a mix of 2-, 3- and 4-bedroom houses. Nine of the 2- and 3-bedroom houses are eligible for shared ownership – a great way for those who can't afford a house on the open market to get on the housing ladder. You are all invited to attend a Community Engagement Meeting on Thursday 26 March at 7pm at the Community Centre in Hawkinge at which both officers from the District Council Community Safety Partnership and Kent Police will be in attendance to discuss any concerns such as anti-social behaviour, drugs etc.

Following requests to replace the North Lyminge street name sign which had become yellowed with age, the officers at the District Council found the official name of the street should be North Lyminge Lane so this is what will appear on the new sign. Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation

You may well kick yourself for not listening properly to the First Aid Courses at work, as the 999 operator is shouting at you down the phone, panic sets in all whilst the ambulance is still en route.

Out-of-Hospital Cardiac Arrest survival rates in the UK are at an average of 7%, and at best 12%. These make for grim statistics, so what can be done?

We can start looking at other areas, like those in Seattle, WA – where they enjoy 21% survival rates, the best in the world. Various factors in their emergency systems differ from UK, but the big difference is that 70% of cardiac arrests are recognised and given bystander CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation), before the ambulance have arrived. In Seattle, CPR and Basic Life Support is taught in all schools and workplaces. Unfortunately, education is not so thorough in the UK, and it is down to the public to educate themselves.

When someone has a cardiac arrest, every minute without CPR and defibrillation increases the chance of death by 7-10%. Additional reasons for delay include;

- · Failure to recognise a cardiac arrest
- Fear of infection from giving rescue breaths
- · Fear of being accused of indecent contact to females
- · Fear of causing harm to patient
- · Fear of being sued
- Not knowing where local AEDs (automated external defibrillator) are or having a previously thought of plan

So, after you have read this, have a think – where is my nearest AED? Am I able to give CPR, potentially to a loved one? Are the people around me also ready?

Pathways to the Past

Exploring the Legacy of Ethelburga

The Big Anglo-Saxon Festival WHITE (countryside is coming!



We are continuing to work on the festival programme, and we hope to be able to announce an initial programme of activities in the very near future. We have events planned throughout 2020 with the main focus of activity being the two weeks 14-31 August when we hope to have something going on each day. Working with a number of professional presenters as well as with village groups, we have lined up a great array of different activities. Handson events such as food preparation, natural dying, basket-weaving and foraging for edible plants will explore the resources of the local environment that were exploited by our Anglo-Saxon ancestors. We will also be organising a workshop to study the burials excavated last summer and to give these medieval villagers some identity before they are re-interred in the churchyard later in the year. There will be walks, talks, displays and performances, and the reenactment group *Øst Centingas* will be making a welcome return. Hopefully there will be something for everyone, so watch this space for more details, or follow our blog at geopaethas.com to get the latest news on the project.

For those of you wondering why work on the new paths in the churchyard has stopped, this is because of the continuing bad weather. We need an extended period of dry weather in order to lay the new path surface. Work will re-commence in the coming weeks, as soon as practicable once the weather improves.

Don't forget you can also still buy **'Diary of a Dig'**, an account of the archaeological dig in the church yard during the summer of 2019 to excavate one of the earliest stone churches in England. This is available either at the Library or from Sunny Cottage, Canterbury Road (behind the Coffee Cabin).

I would like to join John in saying a hearty 'thank you' to Adrian Willcox for his faithfulness in helping to make the Lyminge Newsletter a success for so many years. And also echo John's words of approval and welcome to the new format of the newsletter for 2020 and onwards. Thank you, Peter.

I too noted the decision of the Parish Council to plant trees around the edge of Tayne Field. In answer to the question John asked about whether residents living in Station Rd and Mayfield were consulted, I'd like to say that we are living in a house bordering the field (and have been for 40 years), but nobody has spoken to us about this proposal.

I would like to know where these initiatives come from and why more trees in this particular area are needed just now? Furthermore, I would not want any of the increased Precept monies to be used in this project, as there are sufficient trees already providing a 'screen' around the field

I would also like to say that if there is money available, that the existing trees should be maintained by the Council. When this suggestion has been made to the Council in the past the response has always been that there isn't the money for this work. Hence my resistance to more planting when the existing trees are not properly maintained. Most of the trees are self-seeded and consequently randomly positioned, and when they get very tall they become a danger with some of the strong winds we have had over the years. As John mentioned there is also the question of the shading of our gardens which is a real concern for many of us.

So we would very much appreciate some consultation about this plan. Thank you



LYMINGE PARISH COUNCIL NEWSLETTER MARCH 2020

2020/21 BUDGET & PRECEPT

The Parish Council will increase the precept contribution made by households during the 2020/21 financial year. The precept is how the parish council raises revenue from all the dwellings within the parish area in order to meet its spending requirements for the year ahead. The precept is converted into an amount per council tax band and is collected via the council tax you pay to Folkestone and Hythe District Council.

The budget set by the Parish Council for 2020/21 is £54,720. Compared to last year, this is an increase of £13.18 per year or 25 pence per week for a Band D property and will show on your council tax bill as a 38.9% increase on last year's precept.

What is the precept money used for?

The council uses the available funds to support the following:

- Maintenance of the play equipment
- Mowing of village green spaces
- Maintenance of trees
- Support of the youth club
- Payment of parish clerk which is an essential post
- Maintenance of village assets such as benches and signage
- Supporting community organisations through grants and donations

The previous council did not significantly increase the contribution made by households to the running costs of the village. The new council has ambition to develop the parish to support a number of plans including the delivery of the environmental plan; repair of Ethelburga Well and refurbishment of play equipment. Many of the plans in hand have been driven by residents.

ENVIRONMENT

We are due to renew grass-cutting and ground maintenance contracts imminently and you will see a change in the management of both Court Lodge Green and Well Field. With the Memorial Grove becoming well established, vegetation around the trees will be kept short and further down the slope on Court Lodge Green ("bumpy field") the areas planted with wildflower seeds will be managed to promote their growth and other areas left to encourage biodiversity. The length of the footpath and bridleway will be mown as usual.

In Well field, areas will be left to encourage wildlife, e.g. a strip either side of the Nailbourne. A natural living willow tunnel is planned – more details to follow. Quotations are awaited for the replacement bridge and will be considered by the Council at the earliest opportunity.

The planting of trees has been mentioned in other editions of the newsletter and these will be native species and suitable for their particular site. Small saplings will be planted and parishioners asked to participate in the planting sessions — details appear in the Environmental Group's report this month. Tree work continues to be undertaken in accordance with the Tree Survey commissioned by the Council last year — some of which had to be brought forward due to recent storms.

We have developed communication lines between Lyminge Youth Action (who now have planning permission for the new play area planned for Tayne Field) and the environmental group so that the two can work together with planting that will complement the new play area.

FHDC PLAY AREAS CONSULTATION

Kent Online recently featured an article about FHDC and play areas across the District. This was referring to a consultation document issued just before Christmas with a very short consultation period. It caused concerns in some circles. As the Council owns much of the land on which our play areas stand, and since we already have responsibility for them, the consultation is inapplicable to those sites. There are two small sites, one at Meriden Park and one in Mount Pleasant which are maintained by FHDC. It is these that we may be asked to take over at a future date. If any parishioner requires further clarification, please email the Clerk.

Any parishioner is welcome to email our busy Clerk, Cherri, with questions or queries about the actions or plans the Council has in prospect. If she is not able to answer them straight away, she will refer them to the appropriate councillor or to the Chair, who is always happy to share a cup of coffee at Age UK or in the Library, to listen and advise. Education

Working with local schools has been a real pleasure and is a high priority for Lyminge Climate Action. Here's what has been happening:

Lyminge CEP: Parents, the PFA and staff including science co-ordinator Mrs Cox have worked on the following initiatives:

- Moth trapping sessions have been run with Yr5, by Kate and Dan Bennett
- Fruit snacks are now composted in the wormery, funded by the PFA.
- The pond area has been restored, ready to be developed for the Forest School
- Veg growing areas have been prepared and nectar rich plants added
- Established Green Gang club and Forest School

Watch this space for more work in conjunction with Lyminge CEP

Elham CEP: We have been supporting the school in creating an area of mixed native woodland within their grounds, as part of their forest school.

Saltwood CEP: Cllr. Standen spent a morning with Year 5 supporting a Courageous Advocacy project where the class overwhelmingly chose to focus on the climate emergency. This included a discussion about the importance of trees and the whole class had a go at planting a tree.
